IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear Collector,

As of 1 January 2018 the Royal Mint of Belgium will no longer manufacture the Belgian circulation coins. The production and commercialisation of commemorative coins will also be ceased.

As we go to press, it is yet unknown who will continue these activities. The RMB will communicate this information on its website as soon as there is absolute certainty.

MintInfo 73 will be the last MintInfo the RMB will publish. On practical and organisational grounds, we have decided to only sell the new products on our **website** www.europemint.eu (web shop).

The selling of all the products of the Royal Mint of Belgium will be terminated definitively on **October 25th 2017**. From this date onwards no further orders can be placed by any means.

Besides the internet sales, the RMB also provides three sale days in its buildings on the **Pachecolaan 32 in 1000 Brussels: 4, 5 and 6 October, each day from 9 am to 3 pm.**

If you are considering purchasing the coins on-site, please let us know quickly and preferably beforehand via e-mail: klantenmunt.clientsmonnaie@minfin.fed.be, mentioning your name, client number and the planned date of your visit to the RMB.

In anticipation of this major restructuring, the RMB started selling a selected part of its stock on its website in June and July 2017. The coins that were not offered in June, are now up for sale at heavily reduced prices, **only on our website from the 18th of September onwards**. A selected number will also be sold on-site on the above mentioned dates.

The official presentation of the 2 euro coin issued on the occasion of the 200th anniversary of Ghent University, is scheduled for 28 September. However, you can already place your order for this new 2 euro coin as well as the other new issues and the heavily reduced stock **now**.

These orders, (current offer and stock products), will only be delivered as of 29 September. We will make the necessary efforts to make this go as fast and as smoothly as possible.
